The Defense of Jisr Al Doreaa Practical Exercise 7 "Conduct a Raid" (Instructor Notes)


Practical Exercise Guidance

In his fifth dream 2LT Connors conducts a successful raid on an insurgent cell in Al Doreaa. His success was largely due to tactical patience and good intelligence gathering. Conducting a raid or cordon and search is a complicated task with numerous planning concerns. How would you have conducted the raid?

Task: Create and brief a raid operations order


Conditions: Given the same mission and troops that were available to 2LT Connors.

Standards: Write and brief a five paragraph OPORD for the mission. Include graphics with direct fire control measures, a troop to task matrix with COP security personnel and special teams identified.



Talking Points

- 1. Did the student issue a detailed five paragraph OPORD?
- 2. Has the student created an urban direct fire control system using graphic control measures?



- 3. Has the student divided his forces into special teams such as:
 - a. Support by Fire or Outer cordon
 - b. Inner cordon
 - c. Breach
 - d. Assault
 - e. Aid and Litter
 - f. Tactical Site Exploitation
 - g. Detainee
- 4. Has the student addressed his consequence management plan?
 - a. IO flyers
 - b. Scheduled meetings with local leadership to explain the action
 - c. Follow up HA operations
